Policies

FOOD

Infants are fed in the crib nursery at the direction of the parents. Please note any allergies on the sign-in sheet.

PERSONAL ITEMS

Label all belongings (diaper bags, cups, etc...) with the child's name. Please provide adequate diapers, pull-ups, wipes, creams and a change of clothes in the diaper bag for all children infant – 2 years.

SIGN-IN

Please fill in the sign-in sheet when your child enters the nursery. Pagers are provided as needed for quick and discrete parent contact from any location on the church campus. Indicate cell phone numbers as a back-up to the pager system.

SICK CHILDREN

Please consider other children if your child has a fever, rash, diarrhea or nasal drainage. Should your child become ill while in the nursery, our staff will notify you immediately.

Nursery Vision

We believe that we have the opportunity to nurture and cultivate the seeds of God's love in each child. We seek to provide a loving, safe, Christian atmosphere for the youngest members of God's family. We provide a learning environment where children can begin a lifelong walk with God through hands-on activities, Bible stories, creative play, and sensory learning. We strive to be an example of God's love for all children in our care.

Ministry Purpose

- To build a strong spiritual foundation in the life of each preschooler we teach
- To help preschoolers begin to understand that God is the creator of all things
- To introduce Jesus as God's Son and our best friend; to share the Bible as the truth.

- Provide hands-on, sensory-based Bible lessons, allowing preschoolers to develop problem-solving, sharing, and personal expression in appropriate ways.

- Encourage parents/guardians to actively participate in worship, Bible study, fellowship, and ministry opportunities.

Nursery Classrooms

Crib Nursery (Birth-12 months) Room 128

- Loving interaction integrated with music and sensory play.

Toddler (12 months-2 years) Room 129

- Bible stories.
- music and movement.
- imaginative play.
- sensory learning.
- fine and gross motor learning.

Two Year Nursery (2-3 years) Room 104

- Uses a story-based curriculum that is a journey through the Bible.
- Music, movement and imaginative play in learning stations.

Three Year Nursery (3 years) Room 118

- Children are introduced to Bible stories through dramatic play and cooperative discussion.
- Imaginative play in learning stations and with multiple opportunities for creative artistic expression.



Pagers

Pagers are provided as needed for quick and discrete parent contact from any location on the church campus.

Schedules

Sunday

- 8:15 a.m.-12:15 p.m.
- Nursery care is provided for all children ages infant - 3 years.
- Lessons focus on helping the children discover and grow in their faith in God.

Wednesday Together

- Childcare begins at 5:00 p.m. for infants and toddlers only in Room 128.
- Children over 2 years eat with their families, then can be brought to the nursery to participate in age-appropriate classes.
- Adult classes begin at 6:00 p.m.

Special Events

- Childcare is arranged by the church for special worship services.
- Committees and other groups arrange specific child care for church-related activities
- Childcare should be arranged seven to ten days prior to the event through the nursery supervisor or nursery director.
