

# A Joyful Easter at First Prez

What have the Kingdom Kidz & Youth been up to?

This year, we changed the children's programing to Sunday evenings. That change created an unique opportunity to gather all the kids, preschool through high school, together to study the Bible, learn music, and fellowship during mealtime.

Andrea, the Kingdom Kidz Bible teacher, shares that she "especially enjoyed the Lego creations the Kingdom Kidz made to illustrate Bible stories. Each Sunday night, we read a story and discussed it. Afterward, each child made something with Legos. Then kids would share and explain the connection to the Bible story in ways that were interesting and inspiring - whether it was their idea of what the Tower of Babel might have looked like, or how Lazarus came back from the tomb."

During music time, the children played instruments and games as they learned to read music. They also prepared songs to share in worship based on Scripture and Bible Truths. They sang in harmony and laughed together. They finished their year with an opportunity for all to learn about, play, and explore the pipe organ.

The children's contribution to the Mission Conference week went really well! The children made potholders and refrigerator magnets to sell for the mission offering. They raised \$1,006.33 to purchase the Jesus Storybook Bibles in Haitian Creole for our partner schools in Haiti.

Thank you to all who volunteered their time, talents, and provided meals for the children and youth on Sunday evenings. Kingdom Kidz will break for the summer and resume in the fall for Pre-K 3's through 5th grade. Children's Sunday School will continue through the summer and we hope your children will join us there.
